OUTREACH SERVICES

HELPLINE PROVIDES SUPPORT TO CLIENTS, THEIR FAMILY AND FRIENDS, AND TO PROFESSIONALS SEEKING INFORMATION OR ASSISTANCE IN SUPPORTING A CLIENT. THE HELPLINE ALSO PROVIDES DISTRESS INTERVENTIONS FOR CLIENTS IN NEED OF IMMEDIATE HELP. STAFF WILL PROVIDE ASSISTANCE, TRIAGING, AND REFERRALS FOR FOLLOW UP TO PROVIDE SUPPORT.

OUR SPECIALIZED CRIMINAL JUSTICE NAVIGATORS PROVIDE CRUCIAL ASSISTANCE TO VICTIMS, OFFERING SPECIALIZED SUPPORT TAILORED TO THEIR NEEDS. WE FOCUS ON PROVIDING VICTIM-CENTRIC, CULTURALLY APPROPRIATE, AND TRAUMA-INFORMED CARE TO ENHANCE SERVICES IN AREAS LIKE WETASKIWIN AND COUNTY, PONOKA, AND MASKWACIS. BY COLLABORATING WITH OTHER VICTIM-SERVING ORGANIZATIONS, OUR PROGRAM MAXIMIZES RESOURCES TO SUPPORT VICTIMS NAVIGATING THE CRIMINAL JUSTICE SYSTEM. THROUGH OUR DEDICATED STAFF, ONGOING TRAINING, AND COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT, WE STRIVE TO IMPROVE THE QUALITY AND ACCESSIBILITY OF VICTIM SUPPORT SERVICES, ENSURING THAT VICTIMS RECEIVE THE GUIDANCE AND SUPPORT THEY NEED WITH DIGNITY AND RESPECT.
